Visit one of the most distinguished winemaking Estates in Victoria- From Fathers to Sons, tenth generation winemaker, Ben Portet joins his father, Dominique to pay homage to Andre Portet, hailed from a winemaking pedigree recorded to 1698. Andre` Portet, born on the tiny Cognac Distillery of Le Ris Bellot, he studied a degree in Agricultural Engineering at Montpellier University. The Portet wines to this day reflect the fine quality endured throughout many generations.
